Capital Improvement Program Committee
Minutes November 10, 2005 Meeting

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Shawn Smith at 7:30. Attendees were Shawn Smith, Paul Martin, Sherry Fiske, Allan Pickman and John Kieley. Dave Martz (who has sent a letter of interest re joining the Committee to the Selectmen) also attended.

The Selectmen have still not received a letter of resignation from Steve Andersen. At a recent Board of Selectmen's meeting Tedd Petro said that once Andersen's resignation is received the Selectmen would post the two openings and consider interested candidates.

The minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed. Sherry made a motion to accept them as written and Allan seconded. The minutes were unanimously approved.

The need for a year round kennel for the dog officer was discussed. Currently approximately one dog a month is retained by the dog officer. It was also recognized that the Town of Greenville is in the process of evaluating their kennel needs and the possibility of contracting to use their space (or others) was discussed. Particularly since there is no pressing need in Temple it was agreed to watch the situation in Greenville closely while leaving this item in the Temple CIP for 2010.

It was agreed that Sherry would discuss the Library's CIP needs with Priscilla and if appropriate invite her to the next CIP meeting. Kieley will invite Joe Cournoyer to the next meeting to discuss the Recreation Dept needs.

Paul volunteered to draft the narrative sections of the CIP report this year. It was agreed that the narrative should reflect the need to establish the Skladany land committee and get their recommendations before developing a CIP relative to the town garage, municipal building etc.

Allan reviewed his work to date on the 2006 spreadsheet and agreed to have a disk ready to load on Paul's laptop at the next meeting.

The next meeting will be held at 7:30 next Monday (November 14) at the municipal building.

Kieley proposed that the meeting be adjourned and Allan seconded. The vote to adjourn at 8:25 was unanimous.
