MOTION: Paul moved, John seconded, to approve the 03/14/05 minutes. All were in favor.

Secretary's Report:

- Rec'd copy of 3/9/05 DES letter to Jim and Lynne Pierce regarding their wetlands complaint.
- Rec'd DES letter regarding Dredge and Fill Application from Town of Temple for bridge work at West Rd. and Blood Rd. It was noted that the Town Clerk had not sent a copy of this Dredge and Fill Application to the CC, as is the established procedure. **Paul will send a letter to the Town Clerk, with a copy to the Select Board, bringing this matter to her attention.**
