Minutes of Public Meeting, November 13th, 2006

Opening at 7:00 PM

Minutes of October 23rd meeting were approved.

Reimbursements:

- Honey moved, and Dave seconded, that John Kieley be reimbursed for \$76.84 spent for postage for the TCC Newsletter two weeks ago. All members voted in the affirmative.
- Sean moved, and John seconded, that Honey Hastings, Roger Hatt, and Bruce Kantner each be reimbursed for \$30 which each one spent for the Annual Meeting of NHACC on 11/04/06. All members voted in the affirmative.
- John moved, and Roger seconded, that Honey Hastings be reimbursed for \$14 spent for renewing the TCC USPO mailbox last July. All members voted in the affirmative.

TCC Newsletter: Members agreed that the new newsletter looks great. Thanks were expressed to Connie and also to Sean and all the contributors. *Roger will get copies of both the '05 and current newsletters to Sandy Benotti for the Temple Welcome Wagon. Bruce will send copies to the NHACC.*

Tamposi subdivision and DES: Roger spoke with a DES employee in the Site Specific Department regarding the TCC letter sent to them in August. This person replied that DES generally reviews such applications in the office, but she will write on the TCC letter that we are requesting a site review.

Pond site visits: *Lincoln will visit both the Pratt and Martin ponds. John is waiting for a call from DES to coordinate his visit to the Tamposi pond with DES.*

SWRPC map: *John and Dave will work on gathering information for this map and report at our next meeting.*

Easements: Honey moved, and Lincoln seconded, that the TCC proceed to the next phase in the easement process for the Wolber's property by bringing the matter to the Select Board's attention and then scheduling a public hearing. All members agreed.

There was a full discussion regarding prioritizing easements, criteria review, and consideration of key properties in Temple.

Water Study: The meeting with Chris Covell is scheduled for Dec. 11th, 7:00 PM. *Lincoln will contact Chris to confirm this time. John will email a draft agenda of this meeting for members to consider at the next November meeting.*
