

**CONSERVATION COMMISSION**  
**Minutes of Public Meeting, January 8th, 2007**

**Opening** at 7:10 PM

**Minutes** of Dec. 14<sup>th</sup> visit to Tamposi site and January 8<sup>th</sup> meeting were approved.

**Jennifer Kullgren's Dredge and Fill Application:** Nathan Chamberlin of Meridian Land Service was scheduled to review this application with the TCC but did not come. Members discussed the impact of a proposed log ford crossing. *Roger will write DES concerning this design question.*

**Review of site visit to Tamposi subdivision:** *Roger will call Jocelyn Dagler of DES asking about the use of one easement property to fulfill two, different requirements.*

**Membership update:** Chris Mackensen brought a copy of his letter to the Select Board expressing his interest in filling the Alternate Member position on the TCC which was vacated by Ben Tirey. Chris described his interest and qualifications and answered questions from members.

John Kieley moved, and Dave Repak seconded, that the Conservation Commission recommend to the Select Board the appointment of Chris Mackensen as Alternate Member, with his term expiring in 2008. The vote was unanimous in favor of his appointment. *Roger will convey this recommendation to the Select Board.*

**Report on Jan. 7<sup>th</sup> hike at Wolbers and planning for Feb. 11<sup>th</sup> hike:** Ten people hiked the Wolbers property. All appreciated the land and were in favor of purchasing an easement.

Dave is the contact person for the Feb. 11<sup>th</sup> hike on the Heald Property.

**Preparation for Jan. 22<sup>nd</sup> Hearing on Wolbers easement:** John brought paper copies for a Power Point presentation that describes conservation easements, the proposed Wolbers' easement, and next steps. Members thanked John for a fine job. *Sean offered to transfer the presentation on to Power Poiont and insert Roger's photos.*

**Update on Temple Mtn. project:** (John Kieley departed before this topic.) Bruce was authorized by the TCC to write letters on behalf of the Commission to Representative Irwin and Senator Bragdon expressing strong support of their bill to acquire Temple Mountain as a state reservation. Both of these legislators will join Dick Ober from Monadnock Conservancy to present their bill to the Temple Select Board on Jan. 9<sup>th</sup>.

Meeting ended at 8:50. Next meeting and Hearing is January 22<sup>nd</sup> at Friendship Hall.
