TCC members signed the letter to DES, submitted jointly by the Planning Board and Select Board, recommending a second bridge at the entrance to the Tamposi subdivision.

**Open Space Plan:** Honey moved, and John seconded, that the TCC approve the Temple Open Space Plan with the attached chart on resource values. The vote was unanimous in favor.
