

CONSERVATION COMMISSION
Minutes of Special Meeting, August 4, 2008

Purpose of Meeting:

To discuss with William S. Wildes his Dredge and Fill Application for a pond construction on his property at 350 Hill Road in Temple.

Opening at 6:17 PM at the Town Hall Annex.

Will Wildes presented his Minimum Impact Expedited Application with copies for members. Questions and discussion followed, mostly concerning the slopes and control of runoff from placement of the dredged materials as fill around the pond.

John made a motion that the TCC support Will's application with a few amendments as follows:

- 1) That the slope of fill on the cross section of the pond facing the brook be no greater than 3:1.
- 2) That biocloth be used as erosion control on the 3:1 slope facing the brook.
- 3) That the height of the fill material be no greater than five feet above the existing grade.

Lincoln seconded this motion and the vote in favor was unanimous.

Lincoln will sign the application on behalf of the TCC as soon as Will gives him the revised application that includes the above amendments.
