Final Minutes of Public Meeting

Members present: Sarge Collier (SC), John Kieley (JK), Randy Burnham (RB), Phyllis Mazza (PM), Dan Cournoyer (DC), Vivian Nicholl (VN), Mary Nutting (MN).

Meeting called to order by RB at 7:05 pm.

1. RB opened with items to be discussed during the meeting according to the agenda.
2. Connie Kieley stated that we should pursue applying for the CLG designation certification done for the district. She stated this would involve having a survey done. A Warrant Article would be needed for the purpose of money required. She will provide VN with some suggested survey companies to inquire about the estimated cost.
3. Michelle Clements presented a proposal for a run in shed to be built on her property for the purpose of keeping her two horses. A sample drawing was submitted with the application. There will be two paddocks.
 - A public hearing will be held for a final decision to be made. The notice will be sent to the Monadnock Ledger for a hearing to take place on Monday Oct. 30. Notification to other district members who are materially affected will be sent by VN. RB reminded all members to consider all of the factors involved before making the decision.
4. A review of the draft minutes from August was done. A motion was made by RB to accept the August minutes. JK seconded. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.
5. A review of the draft minutes from Sept. was done.

Corrections to be made were:

 - Motion made by JK to accept the September minutes as amended. RB seconded. DC was not in favor and questioned reference to his statement about political signs. VN corrected the statement in question as according to DC.
 - Motion made by JK to accept the September minutes as amended. RB seconded. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.
6. RB went forward with the agenda and discussion about the procedures. He stressed the importance of being consistent with our decisions.

7. JK suggested having a format for the guide book
8. SC made a motion to have an agenda item at the next meeting to discuss everyone's understanding of the ordinance.
9. RB moved to adjourn the meeting at 9:10 pm. PM seconded. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.
