**FINAL MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC MEETING**

**BOARD OF SELECTMEN**

Meeting held on the 20<sup>th</sup> of March 2007

Board members present: S. Fiske, J. Kieley, T. Petro

Call to Order by S. Fiske at 7:00 p.m.

Approval of prior minutes: The 3/13/07 minutes will be reviewed at the 3/27/07 meeting.

**Regular Business**

1. Subject: Petro spoke to the Board about items discussed at the 3/13/07 meeting. Petro suggested a possible compromise on the Sullivan LUCT abatement request. A letter to Sullivan and Avitar will be reviewed for signature at the 3/27/07 meeting requesting clarification of the LUCT issue. Petro questioned the discussion of the Doug Guy dealer plate request. Kieley explained the history of the Guy situation to Petro; a letter to Attorney Drescher will be reviewed at the 3/27/07 meeting. Petro asked about the Wolbers easement and suggested that the Conservation Commission bring it before the Board of Selectmen again.
  
2. Subject: The Board discussed roles for 2007. Move by Kieley to nominated Petro as Chairman of the Board of Selectmen, second by Petro and voted Kieley and Petro in favor, Fiske abstained. Petro stated that he would be willing to re-visit the chairman position later in the year. The Board unanimously agreed to the following allocation of positions: Fiske and Kieley will be the Representatives to the Joint Police Board; Fiske will be the Representative to the Ambulance; Fiske will work on the Recycling Center Contract; Kieley will be the Ex-officio to the Planning Board, to be reviewed after the March 2008 elections; Kieley will be the Representative to the Historic District Commission; Petro will serve on the Conval Selectmen's Advisory Committee; Petro will attend Budget Advisory Committee meetings; Fiske's term on the Capital Improvements Committee has not expired. Further discussion on the Emergency Mgmt./Hazard Mitigation Committee, Town Hall and the "Green" Committee will occur at a future meeting. Kieley submitted a list of key projects for 2007. The Administrative Assistant will type this list up for review at the 3/27/07 meeting.

3. Subject: Discussion of open positions for 2007. The Administrative Assistant will post open positions. The Board will review letters of interest received to date at the 3/27/07 meeting. The Board will also review recommendations from Boards and Commissions.  
Discussion of the Treasurers position. Fiske introduced Mary Amsden, a potential candidate for the position. The Board determined that the Treasurers position would be posted separately; Candidates will be requested to submit a letter of interest, and brief resume. Discussion of completing a background check occurred.  
Discussion of re-posting the "Notice of Intent to Request Release of Funds" for the HUD Grant. Move by Kieley to re-post the notice, second by Petro and voted in the unanimous affirmative.  
Petro informed the Board that he does not deal with email. Information should be emailed to the Town Offices to be put in his box. If there is an emergency Petro should be contacted by phone. Kieley suggested that all email should go through the Town Offices and the Administrative Assistant could put the information the Board members boxes.  
Petro requested an update on the Town Hall. The Friends of Temple Town Hall will meet with the Board Tuesday, March 27, 2007 at 7:30 p.m. for a discussion on how to move forward with the Town Hall project.  
The Board reviewed the revised Architects contract for the Historic portion of the Town Hall. The Administrative Assistant will contact Attorney Drescher to review the changes.
4. Subject: Mike Darnell requested permission from the Board to hold a forum for residents to discuss ComCast. Darnell informed the Board that there are 211 households hooked up to cable.  
Darnell spoke to the Board about a possible open well on the Tyler/Katherman property on Cutter Road. Petro will look at the property. The Board asked Darnell to speak to the Library Trustees about maintaining the Library computers.  
Connie Kieley suggested that the Town purchase a bulk mail permit to reduce the cost of mailings, no action taken at this time.
5. Subject: Move by Petro to adjourn, second by Kieley. Meeting adjourned at 9:03 p.m.
