**FINAL MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC MEETING  
BOARD OF SELECTMEN**

Meeting held on the 22<sup>ND</sup> of May 2007

Board members present: T. Petro, S. Fiske, J. Kieley

Call to Order by T. Petro at 7:03 p.m.

Approval of prior minutes: Move by Fiske to approve the 4/24/07 minutes as amended, second by Kieley and voted in the unanimous affirmative. Move by Petro to approve the 4/24/07 non-public minutes, second by Kieley and voted in the unanimous affirmative. Move by Fiske to approve the 5/8/07 minutes as amended, second by Kieley and voted in the unanimous affirmative. Move by Petro to approve the 5/8/07 non-public minutes, second by Kieley and voted in the unanimous affirmative.

**Regular Business**

1. Subject: Dick Benotti met with the Board to discuss repairing and improving the driveway into M 07 L 046, owned by the Temple Congregational Church, off of NH RT 45. The Board directed Benotti to discuss this with the Road Agent and the State of NH-DOT.
2. Subject: Lincoln Geiger, Chairman of the Conservation Commission (ConCom), met with the Board to inform them that the ConCom had voted to donate \$30,000.00 from the Conservation Fund toward the State of New Hampshire's purchase of Temple Mountain. Move by Fiske to approve a donation of \$30,000.00 from the Conservation Fund for the State of New Hampshire's purchase of Temple Mountain, contingent upon State Legislative approval and State funding, second by Petro and voted Petro and Fiske in the affirmative. Kieley recused himself from the discussion and vote.
3. Subject: Reviewed and signed vouchers.  
Reviewed and signed intents to cut for the following: Dorothea Guy, M 02 Lots 071-2 & 071-3; John Kieley, M 02 L 079.  
Reviewed and signed the restated contract for the Wilton Recycling Center between the Town of Wilton and the Town of Temple.  
Reviewed the 2007-2008 Health Trust agreement for the health insurance rates. Petro signed as Chairman.  
Discussion of the diesel and heating oil contracts. The Board would be willing to meet with Draper Energy to determine what Draper has to offer in terms of pricing. Kieley informed the Board that all the Town's involved in the Irving Oil contract had billing problems with Irving. The Town Administrators/Admin. Assist. will be meeting with an Irving representative.

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3. Subject: (Cont.) Signed the appointment form for George Willard to the BAC.  
Reviewed and signed the brush fire bill for Karine Munk and Torin Finser of Kendall Road.  
Discussion of the reclamation of the Wegmueller gravel pit. The Administrative Assistant will speak to the Road Agent regarding purchase of gravel from the Wegmueller gravel pit. The Board determined that the Planning Board has the responsibility to monitor the reclamation of the pit.  
Reviewed and signed the warrant for the 2007 1<sup>st</sup> property tax billing.  
Reviewed and signed the excavation tax warrant for Robbins and an abatement for the amount of gravel purchased by the Town of Temple.  
Reviewed a letter from Sam Proctor of Proctor & Greene in response to the Board's letter about the listing of the Fu property. The Administrative Assistant will compose and sign a letter for the Board informing Proctor that the Board considers the special exception granted to the prior owners, Moses, to have been abandoned.  
Kieley informed the Board that there would be a trial management conference for the Peterson ZBA case on Friday, May 25, 2007. Dwight Sowerby of Drescher & Dokmo requested that a Board member be available. Kieley may appear at court; Fiske would be available by phone. The Administrative Assistant informed the Board that Sowerby would forward recommendations regarding the Doug Guy case to the Board. The Board requested that the Administrative Assistant send a letter to Mr. Carrigan at the State of NH-DES requesting information regarding the Tyler property on Cutter Road.  
Move by Fiske to appoint Honey Hastings to the "Green Committee", second by Kieley and voted in the affirmative.  
The Board discussed the Treasurer's position. The Administrative Assistant will be meeting with Nancy Woods, Acting Treasurer, on Friday, May 25, 2007. The Board requested that the Admin. Assist. get a response from Woods regarding the Treasurers position for discussion at the 6/12/07 meeting to allow a decision at the 6/26/07 meeting.  
The Administrative Assistant gave the Board a brief update on the status of the FEMA information regarding the April 2007 Nor'easter.
4. Subject: Move by Petro to adjourn, second by Kieley. Meeting adjourned at 8:02 p.m.
