**FINAL MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC MEETING  
BOARD OF SELECTMEN  
Meeting held on the 6<sup>th</sup> of November 2007**

Board members present: Tedd Petro, Sherry Fiske, John Kieley

Call to Order by Petro at 6:38 p.m.

Approval of prior minutes:

1. Subject: Signed 2007 second billing property tax warrant.  
Signed State of NH-DRA equalization certificate.  
Petro signed a letter to Luke Peterson regarding zoning violations.  
The Board signed a letter to the U.S. Consulate in Germany regarding the Lukas Foundation.  
The Board discussed a date for the forum. Kieley suggested mid to late January 2008. Petro suggested and the Board agreed to January 17, 2008, 7:00 p.m. at the Town Hall with a snow date of January 24, 2007. The Board decided that the topics to be discussed would be Police, Ambulance and driveway plowing.
2. Subject: Connie Kieley, representing the Friends of Temple Town Hall (FTTH) informed the Board that they are waiting for two change orders from West Rindge Builders (WRB) for work at the Town Hall. The doorsill under the Handicapped entrance is rotted. FTTH is recommending that the change order to repair be approved at cost plus with a cap of \$2,700.00. There is also a need to change some of the electrical work and FTTH has received an estimate of \$2,700.00. Move by Fiske to allow Petro to sign the work change orders upon receipt for no more than \$2,700.00 each, second by J. Kieley and voted in the unanimous affirmative.  
C. Kieley informed the Board that FTTH had been given initial approval by the LCHIP Board to announce receipt of an LCHIP grant. The Board congratulated FTTH for the approval of the LCHIP grant.
3. Subject: S. Fiske informed the Board that Tim Fiske, Road Agent, had suggested that if the storage shed for the Fire Department is rebuilt that it be built large enough to house the heating oil tank. By putting the oil tank under cover it will alleviate the possibility of ice falling from the roof slicing the line to the furnace and causing another oil spill. The Board agreed and S. Fiske will speak to Fire Engineer Wil Wildes.
4. Subject: S. Fiske gave the Board a budget worksheet for the ambulance that she had compiled. The Board discussed the cost difference between Wilton and Peterborough for ambulance service. Fiske stated that the Wilton service provides ALS (advanced life support) 24/7 while Peterborough provides ALS most of the time. Wilton covers 3 towns while Peterborough currently covers

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4. Subject: (cont) 6 towns, if Temple were to contract with Peterborough it would cover 7 towns. Peterborough ambulance will only transport to Monadnock Hospital, Wilton ambulance will transport to Monadnock Hospital or to Nashua and occasionally to Manchester. Fiske also informed the Board that Wilton is looking to purchase a new ambulance in 2010 at a cost of \$160,000. Wilton is requesting that Temple contribute \$16,000 in 2008 and 2009 toward the cost of this ambulance. Currently the oldest ambulance is 10 years old. Kieley suggested that the Board determine what Temple would be giving up regarding the ambulance building and ambulances and what would be included in service from Peterborough. Fiske suggested that this Board meet with the Wilton Board of Selectmen. Petro will contact Peterborough.
  
5. Subject: Move by Petro to adjourn, second by Fiske. Meeting adjourned at 7:17 p.m.
