

USING ABSENTEE BALLOTS IN TEMPLE

1. Who can use an absentee ballot?

You can use an absentee ballot if any of the following apply:

- a. You will be absent from town on Election Day, or during the hours that the polls are open.
- b. You are unable to vote in person because of physical disability.
- c. You cannot appear in public on election day due to observance of a religious commitment

2. How can I get an absentee ballot?

The Town Clerk provides absentee ballots. You must apply in writing. You may use the application form below, or a letter, or a form available from the Town Clerk. You can either see the Town Clerk in person at the Municipal Building or mail or fax in the application. When your completed application is received, the Town Clerk will give (or send) you a ballot.

The normal business hours are Tuesday Wednesday and Thursday 9 am - 2 pm. (You can also make an off-hours appointment.) The Town Clerk is usually available at the town offices on the day before Election Day, from 3-5 pm.

3. How can I submit my absentee ballot?

The absentee ballots can be hand-carried or mailed to the Town Clerk at any time prior to Election Day. (The ballots may not be faxed in.) On Election Day, the only way to submit a ballot is by the US Postal Service. The Town Clerk checks the PO box before the Post Office closes on Election Day.
